about 2.0 miles along the aforesaid centerline to its intersection with the boundary line of Oxon Hill Election District thence generally northeasterly about 2.0 miles along the aforesaid boundary line to the place of beginning.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of the Maryland-Washington Metropolitan District Act, no metropolitan district tax money collected in Prince George's County as the result of any area being included the Maryland-Washington within the boun daries of Metropolitan District shall be expended maintenance, improvement, acquisition or purchase of any park site or recreational area beyond and without the boundaries of the said Maryland-Washington Metropolitan District.

No municipal corporation within the areas added subsection (d) to the Maryland-Washington Metropolitan District shall be authorized, by means of an amendment to its charter or otherwise, to exercise any of the powers relating to planning, subdivision control granted to the and/or zoning DOA OL hereafter Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission or the County Commissioners of Prince George's County. this subsection shall for any reason be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, it is hereby declared to be the intention of the General Assembly that this subsection would have been enacted without invalid portions.

- (e) 1961 Addition in Prince George's County. The boundaries of the Metropolitan District are extended by the addition thereto of the five (5) following described areas, which said areas shall hereafter become integral portions of the Metropolitan District:
- Beginning at the northeasternmost corner of Vansville Election District (No. 1) at its intersection with Brock Bridge Road and Bowie Road, thence in a northeasterly direction along Brock Bridge Road, being the dividing line between the Laurel Election District (No. 10) and the Bowie Election District approximately 0.3 mile to its intersection with the River, Patuxent being the County line: southeasterly with the Paturent River and the County line its intersection with the westerly right-of-way line of the Baltimore-Washington Parkway; thence southerly with and along the westerly right-of-way line of said parkway approximately 2.3 miles to its intersection Swampoodle Road, being a leg of the dividing line between the Vansville Election District (No. 1) and the Bowie Election District (No. 14); thence in a northwesterly and northeasterly direction along said dividing
