approximately 2.8 miles to the place of beginning.

- (2) All of the Berwyn Election District (No. 21) not previously included within said Metropolitan District, excepting therefrom, however, the city of Greenbelt.
- (3) All of Lanham Election District (No. 20) not previously included within said Metropolitan District.
- (4) Beginning at the intersection of the existing Metropolitan District boundary and Ritchie Road, being the dividing line between Seat Pleasant Election District (No. 18) and Kent Election District (No. 13) and running thence southeasterly along the centerline of said Ritchie Road approximately 1.1 miles to its intersection with the Porestville Ritchie Road; thence southwesterly along the Forestville Ritchie Road approximately 0.15 mile to its intersection with the dividing line between Spalding's Election District (No. 6) and Melwood Election District (No. 15); thence along said election district dividing line 0.08 mile to its intersection with the boundary line the Maryland-Washington Regional District established in 1947; thence in a southerly direction along said Regional District boundary line approximately 4.64 miles to its intersection with Suitland Parkway, being the dividing line between Spalding's Election District (No. 6) and Melwood Election District (No. 15); thence in a westerly direction along said approximately 0.7 mile to its intersection with Allentown Road; thence southwesterly along said Allentown Road approximately 6.34 miles to its intersection with the existing Retropolitan District line at Palmers Corner thence northerly along said Metropolitan District line to the place of beginning, excepting therefrom, however, the town of District Heights.
- (f) 1963 Addition. The boundaries of the Metropolitan District ar extended by the addition thereto of the following desc ibed areas, which said areas shall hereafter become integral portions of the Metropolitan District:
- (1) All of the Surratt's Election District (No. 9).
- (2) All of the Spaulding's Election District (No. 6) not previously included within said Metropolitan District excluding, however, the Municipal Corporation of District Heights.
- (3) All of the Kent Election District (No. 13) not previously included within said Metropolitan District.
