Whenever it is deemed necessary by the Commission to take or acquire any lands, water rights, structures, or buildings, either in fee or as an easement, for parks, parkways, forests. roads, streets, boulevards, highways, ground or spaces, or for the purposes the Commission may purchase [the same] THEM recreation, from the owner or owners; or, failing to agree with or owners thereof, may condemn the same by proceedings in the Circuit Court for the county in which land, water rights, structures, or buildings are The procedure shall be that located. applying to condemnation of land by public service corporations in TITLE 12 OF THE REAL PROPERTY Article [33A] of the CODE OF Public General Laws of Maryland. At the same time, the Commission may condemn the interest of any tenant, lessee, or other person having an interest in the land or other property. At any time after ten days after the return and recordation of the verdict or award in proceedings, the Commission may enter and take possession of the property so condemned, upon first paying to the clerk of the court the amount of the award and all costs to date, notwithstanding any appeal or further proceedings on the part of the defendant. At the time of this payment, however, the Commission shall give undertaking to abide by and fulfill corporate any judgment on such appeal, or on the expiration of appeal time limit if there be no appeal.
