[(f)] The County Commissioners of Prince George's County [shall have the power to] MAY appoint from time to time [such] WHATEVER advisory committees on recreation as it may deem necessary in furtherance of the powers and functions herein granted [;provided, however]. HOWEVER, there shall be at all times a standing advisory committee on recreation which shall be as representative of the citizens of the county as possible. Recommendations regarding the functions and membership of the advisory committees [may], from time to time, MAY be made by the Board.

[ (p) ] The Board shall prepare and submit to the County Commissioners an annual budget, including a of recreation activities and programs. schedule Review a f the Board's proposed budget by the Commissioners and approval of the schedule of recreation activities and programs which shall be contained therein shall constitute concurrence in the recreation activities and programs proposed for any fiscal year. The County Commissioners may modify or change the schedule contained in [said] THE proposed budget.
