Senate Bill No. 1104 - Conversion of Property into Condominium

## AN ACT concerning

## Condominium Act

FOR the purpose of clarifying and setting forth the required procedures and notice to tenants of a landlord's intent to convert property into a condominium; clarifying the bylaw requirements, contents of the condominium plat to be filed, the percentage interest of each unit owner, the procedure to establish a lien for delinquent assessments, repair and reconstruction provisions, books and records, conflict in provisions of the law, and easements for support; clarifying and adding to the disclosure requirements; and adding exemption of unit owners from liability from certain claims; generally concerning certain common elements; and generally clarifying the Condominium Act.
