Therefore, it is unnecessary for me to sign House Bill 986.

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore City - Street Lighting Bond Issue

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to create a debt, and to issue and sell its certificates of indebtedness as evidence thereof, to an amount not exceeding One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00), the proceeds derived from the sale of the certificates of indebtedness to be used for the purpose of extending, improving and modernizing the lighting system used for the illumination of the highways, streets, alleys and other public ways in the City of Baltimore, including, but not limited to, the conversion of
