Pursuant to the provisions of Section 23-11 of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the State Administrative Board of Election Laws does hereby certify that at the General Election held in the State of Maryland on November 5, 1974, an Act known as Chapter 889 of the Acts of 1974 was submitted to the voters of the State of Maryland under the provisions of Article XIV of the Constitution of the State of Maryland, said Act being as follows:

AN ACT concerning Baltimore City Criminal Court — Office of the Clerk. For the purpose of providing that in Baltimore City all employees of the Clerk of the Criminal Court shall be appointed or removed according to the merit system procedure established by law for deputies and clerks, clarifying language, and submitting this amendment to the qualified voters of the State for adoption or rejection.

And it is hereby certified that at said election, 367,657 votes were cast for the adoption of said Chapter 889 and 106,136 votes were cast against the adoption of said Chapter 889, the said Chapter 889 of the Acts of 1974 has therefore been ratified by the qualified voters of Baltimore City of the State of Maryland.
