And it is hereby certified that at said election, 6,034 votes were cast for the adoption of said Chapter 599 and 4,037 votes were cast against the adoption of said Chapter 599, the said Chapter 599 of the Acts of 1973 has therefore been ratified by the qualified voters of Carroll County.
