- Six persons shall be appointed by the (2) Governor from among the residents and registered voters of the Judicial Circuit. These persons may not lawyers, elected State officials. OI full-time employees of the State. Ιf the Judicial Circuit contains more than one county, at least one person shall be from each county in the appointed Circuit, and shall be a resident and registered voter of such county.
- shall be members of (3) Six persons the Marvland Bar who reside and registered voters in the Circuit. They shall be elected by the members of the Maryland Bar who reside registered voters in the Circuit. election shall be conducted by the State Court Administrator pursuant to rules promulgated by the Court of Appeals.
- (4) The State Court Administrator is, ex officio, the non-woting Secretary of each Commission.

(b) Terms

The terms of the members of the Commissions are coextensive with the term of the Governor and until their successors are duly chosen.

(c) <u>Vacancies</u>

If a vacancy occurs on a Commission reason of the death, resignation, or disqualification of a member appointed by the Governor, his successor shall be appointed by the Governor in accordance with Paragraph 4(a). If the vacancy occurs reason of death, by the resignation or disqualification of a member elected by the members of the Bar, his successor shall be selected pursuant to rules promulgated by the Court of Appeals.

(d) Ineligibility for Judicial Appointment

The Governor shall not appoint a member of these Commissions to a vacancy on a Trial Court during the term for which they were chosen.
