July 29, August 5, and August 12, 1974.

SECTION III: AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS that the Mayor is hereby specifically commanded to carry out provisions of Section II hereof, and, as evidence of such shall cause to be affixed to the compliance. the Mayor Minutes of this meeting appropriate certificates publication of the newspaper or newspapers in which the title of the Resolution shall have been published shall declare the Charter change hereby enacted to be effective on August 27, 1974, or following a favorable referendum thereon, by affixing his signature hereto in the space provided on the effective date of change.

SECTION IV: AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS that as soom as the Charter amendment herey enacted shall become effective, either as provided herein or following a referendum, the Mayor shall send separately by registered mail, to the Secretary of State of Maryland and to the Department of Legislative Reference of Maryland a clear certified copy of this Resolution showing the number of Aldermen voting for and against it and a report on the votes cast for or against the amendment hereby enacted at any referendum thereon and the date of such referendum.

The above Charter Amendment was enacted by the foregoing Resolution which was passed at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis, July 8, 1974, the Mayor and eight (8) Aldermen voting in the affirmative, no Aldermen voting in the negative, no Aldermen abstaining, no Aldermen absent, and the said Resolution becomes effective in accordance with law on the 27th day of August, 1974.
