

BERWYN HEIGHTS

THERE SHALL BE VOTER REGISTRATION THE FIRST MONDAY, TUESDAY, AND WEDNESDAY OF APRIL OF EACH ELECTION YEAR BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:00 P.M. AND 10:00 P.M. APPLICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION SHALL BE ACCEPTED BY THE TOWN CLERK-TREASURER OR BY OTHERS SO AUTHORIZED BY THE COUNCIL ON THESE DAYS AND BETWEEN THE HOURS ABOVE SPECIFIED, AND AT ANY OTHER TIME DURING NORMAL TOWN OFFICE HOURS, EXCEPT THAT THE REGISTRATION SHALL BE CLOSED TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO ALL ELECTIONS. SUCH APPLICATION SHALL BE IN WRITING, UNDER OATH OR AFFIRMATION, AND SHALL BE IN SUCH FORM AS THE COUNCIL SHALL PRESCRIBE.

THE TOWN CLERKS OR ANY NOTARY PUBLIC IS HEREBY VESTED WITH AUTHORITY TO ADMINISTER THE REQUIRED OATH OR AFFIRMATION IN RESPECT OF ANY APPLICATION FOR VOTER REGISTRATION.

REGISTRATION SHALL BE PERMANENTLY RECORDED AND NO PERSON SHALL BE ENTITLED TO VOTE IN TOWN ELECTIONS UNLESS HE IS REGISTERED. THE JUDGES OF ELECTIONS SHALL KEEP THE REGISTRATION LISTS UP TO DATE BY STRIKING FROM THE LISTS PERSONS KNOWN TO HAVE DIED, TO HAVE MOVED OUT OF THE TOWN, OR TO HAVE OTHERWISE BECOME DISQUALIFIED. THE COUNCIL, BY ORDINANCE, SHALL ADOPT AND ENFORCE ANY PROVISIONS NECESSARY TO ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A SYSTEM OF PERMANENT REGISTRATION AND PROVIDE FOR A RE-REGISTRATION WHEN NECESSARY.

(H) APPEAL

IF ANY PERSON IS AGGRIEVED BY THE ACTION OF ANY VOTER REGISTRATION OFFICER OR THE JUDGES OF ELECTIONS IN REFUSING TO REGISTER OR IN STRIKING OFF THE NAME OF ANY PERSON, OR BY ANY OTHER ACTION, HE MAY APPEAL TO THE COUNCIL. ANY DECISION OR ACTION OF THE COUNCIL UPON SUCH APPEALS MAY BE APPEALED TO THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR THE COUNTY WITHIN THE TIME ALLOWED FOR SUCH APPEALS.

(I) NOMINATIONS

PERSONS, MEETING THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP ON THE COUNCIL MAY BE NOMINATED BY FILING A CERTIFICATE OF NOMINATION AT THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, CLERK-TREASURER, OR TOWN CLERK ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST TUESDAY IN MARCH NEXT PRECEDING THE TOWN ELECTION. SAID CERTIFICATES OF NOMINATION SHALL BE IN THE FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE COUNCIL. NO PERSON SHALL FILE FOR NOMINATION TO MORE THAN ONE ELECTIVE TOWN PUBLIC OFFICE OR HOLD MORE THAN ONE ELECTIVE TOWN PUBLIC OFFICE AT ANY ONE TIME.
