and exact copy of the Resolution shall be posted in the City Municipal Building until March 23, 1974 and a fair summary of the Amendment shall be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the City not less than four (4) times at weekly intervals by March 23, 1974.

Section 3: That as soon as the Charter Amendment hereby enacted shall become effective, either as herein provided or following a referendum, the Bowie City Manager shall send separately, by registered mail, to the Secretary of State of Maryland, and to the Department of Legislative Reference, the following information concerning the Charter Amendment; (1) The complete text of this Resolution; (2) the date of referendum election, if any, held with respect thereto; (3) the number of votes cast for and against this Resolution by the Council of the City of Bowie or in a referendum; and (4) the effective date of the Charter Amendment.

Section 4: That the Manager of the City of Bowie be, and he is specifically enjoined and instructed to carry out the provisions of Section 2 and 3 as evidence of compliance herewith; the said Manager shall cause to be affixed to the minutes of this meeting (1) an appropriate certificate of publication of the newspaper in which the fair summary of the Amendment shall have been published; and (2) return receipts of the mailing referred to in Section 3, and shall further complete and execute the Certificate of Effect attached hereto.

Section 5: That this Resolution and Amendment rescind Section 16 enacted March 13, 1963 to become effective on May 2, 1963.

A RESOLUTION TO REPEAL AND RE-ENACT WITH AMENDMENTS SECTION 16-37 OF ARTICLE IV OF THE CHARTER OF BRUNSWICK, TITLE "TOWN COUNCIL", SUBTITLE "MEETINGS", (THE CODE OF THE COUNTY OF FREDERICK, MARYLAND) TO PROVIDE THAT THE MEMBERS-ELECT OF THE TOWN COUNCIL SHALL MEET ON THE SECOND TUESDAY IN AUGUST SUCCEEDING THEIR ELECTION, AND SHALL TAKE BEFORE THE MAYOR THE OATH OF OFFICE REQUIRED
