RESOLUTION of The Commissioners of Cambridge adopted pursuant to the authority of Article 11F of the Constitution of Maryland and Section 13 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1973 Replacement Volume), entitled "Corporation - Municipal" to amend the Charter of The Commissioners of Cambridge by repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Section 29 entitled "Records; minute, ordinance, general record books." Subsection (e) entitled "Extracts" and Subsection (f) entitled "Use" of the Code of Public Local Laws of Dorchester County (1961 Edition), said Code being Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland entitled "Dorchester County", subtitled "Cambridge", removing obsolete reference to Justice of the Peace and providing for payment of extracts of records.
