RESOLUTION of The Commissioners of Cambridge adopted pursuant to the authority of Article 11E of the Constitution of Maryland and Section 13 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1973 Replacement Volume), titled "Corporation-Municipal" to amend the Charter of The Commissioners of Cambridge by repealing Section 92 entitled "Same; distribution of fines" of the Code of Public Local Laws of Dorchester County (1961 Edition), said Code being Article 10 of the Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled "Dorchester County", subtitled "Cambridge", by repealing references to distributions of fines, now being obsolete.

SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED by The Commissioners of Cambridge that Section 92 of the Charter of said municipal corporation, entitled "Same; distribution of fines" be, and the same is hereby repealed.
