

CHARLESTOWN

WITH ANY PARTY OR PARTIES, INSIDE OR OUTSIDE THE TOWN, TO OBTAIN WATER OR TO PROVIDE FOR THE REMOVAL OF SEWAGE.

M. CHARGES

THE TOWN MAY CHARGE AND COLLECT SUCH SERVICE RATES, WATER RENTS, READY-TO-SERVE CHARGES, OR OTHER CHARGES AS IT DEEMS NECESSARY FOR WATER SUPPLIED AND FOR THE REMOVAL OF SEWAGE. THESE CHARGES ARE TO BE BILLED AND COLLECTED BY THE CLERK-TREASURER, AND IF BILLS ARE UNPAID WITHIN THIRTY DAYS, THE SERVICE MAY BE DISCONTINUED. ALL CHARGES SHALL BE A LIEN ON THE PROPERTY, COLLECTIBLE IN THE SAME MANNER AS TOWN TAXES OR BY SUIT AT LAW.

N. EXCEPTION

THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBHEADING SHALL NOT EXTEND TO ANY TOWN LOCATED IN A SANITARY DISTRICT OR SPECIAL TAX AREA OR DISTRICT AUTHORIZED TO DISCHARGE THE POWERS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBHEADING, AS TO THE PARTICULAR POWERS INCLUDED IN THE AUTHORIZATION.

Section 2. And be it further resolved that the amendment proposed in this Resolution shall become and be considered a part of the Charter of the Town of Charlestown according to the terms of the amendment, in all respects to be effective and observed as such, upon July 31, 1974, unless on or before July 21, 1974, there shall be presented to the Board of Commissioners a proper petition for referendum as permitted by law.

Section 3. And be it further resolved that the President of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Charlestown be, and he is hereby specifically directed to post a complete and exact copy of this Resolution at the Town Hall or other main municipal building or public place for a period of forty days following its adoption by the Board of Commissioners and to cause a fair summary of the proposed amendments to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the town not less than four times, at weekly intervals, within a period of at least forty days after adoption of this Resolution.

Section 4. And be it further resolved that as soon as the charter amendment hereby proposed shall become effective either as herein provided or following a referendum, the President of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Charlestown shall send separately by registered mail to the Secretary of State of Maryland and to the Department of Legislative Reference, the following information concerning the charter amendment:
