BECOME ABSENT OR ENGAGED IN SUCH SERVICE FOR THE ENTIRE PERIOD HE HAS BEEN SO ABSENT OR ENGAGED.

(D) WHEN PROPERLY REGISTERED UNDER THIS SECTION, A PERSON SHALL CONTINUE AS A REGISTERED VOTER TO THE SAME EXTENT AND FOR THE SAME PERIOD THAT HE WOULD BE REGISTERED HAD HE APPEARED IN PERSON AND BEEN REGISTERED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE ELECTION LAWS OF EASTON, EXCLUSIVE OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following new Sections 30-1 through 30-9 of the Charter of the Town of Easton, all being part of Article V thereof, shall be and are hereby added to said Charter of the Town of Easton, which new Sections shall read as follows:

SEC. 30-1. WHO MAY VOTE.

THE FOLLOWING PERSONS MAY VOTE AS AN ABSENTEE VOTER UNDER THIS SUBTITLE:

(A) ANY QUALIFIED VOTER WHO IS REGISTERED TO VOTE AND MAY BE UNAVOIDABLY ABSENT FROM EASTON FOR ANY REASON ON ANY ELECTION DAY; AND

(B) ANY QUALIFIED PERSON AS DEFINED IN § 30-2 OF THIS ARTICLE.

SEC. 30-2. VOTING BY ILL AND DISABLED PERSONS; EMERGENCY ABSENTEE BALLOTS.

(A) APPLICATION AND MEDICAL CERTIFICATE; PROCEDURE FOR VOTING. - ANY QUALIFIED VOTER WHOSE PHYSICAL DISABILITY OR CONFINEMENT PREVENTS OR WILL PREVENT HIM FROM BEING PRESENT AND PERSONALLY VOTING AT THE POLLS ON ANY ELECTION DAY SHALL ALSO BE ENTITLED TO VOTE AS AN ABSENTEE VOTER UNDER THIS SUBTITLE. SUCH VOTER SHALL MAKE APPLICATION FOR AN ABSENTEE BALLOT AS PROVIDED IN § 30-4 OF THIS ARTICLE. THE APPLICATION SHALL BE FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS NOT LATER THAN SEVEN (7) DAYS PRIOR TO ANY ELECTION. UPON RECEIPT OF THE APPLICATION THE SUPERVISOR SHALL MAIL TO THE VOTER ENTITLED THERETO AN ABSENTEE BALLOT. IN ALL OTHER RESPECTS, ABSENTEE VOTING AS PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE SIMILAR TO AND CONTROLLED BY THE APPLICABLE PROCEDURE PROVIDED BY LAW FOR ABSENTEE VOTING.

(B) ASSISTANCE IN MARKING BALLOT, ETC. - ANY OTHERWISE QUALIFIED VOTER WHO IS BLIND, PHYSICALLY DISABLED OR WHO HAS IMPAIRED VISION AND IS FOR ONE OF
