Section 1-217

(12A) AGENT, RELOCATION. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL, PREFERABLY COMPLETION OF A TWO (2) YEAR COMMUNITY COLLEGE PROGRAM AND THREE (3) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN REAL ESTATE AND/OR REAL ESTATE APPRAISAL TECHNIQUES; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(16A) ANALYST, PROGRAMMER. GRADUATION FROM A UNIVERSITY OR COLLEGE OF RECOGNIZED STANDING, WITH SPECIALIZATION IN ACCOUNTING, STATISTICS, MATHEMATICS, OR ENGINEERING, FOUR (4) YEARS OF RELATED WORK EXPERIENCE, TWO (2) OF WHICH MUST HAVE BEEN IN THE DESIGN AND/OR PROGRAMMING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF INTEGRATED SYSTEMS; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(19A) ANALYST, ZONING, PRINCIPAL. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY WITH FOUR (4) YEARS OF SUB-PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE OR GRADUATION FROM HIGH SCHOOL AND EIGHT (8) YEARS OF PROGRESSIVELY RESPONSIBLE PLANNING EXPERIENCE; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(75A) CHIEF, QUALITY AND CONTROL DIVISION. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED COLLEGE WITH A DEGREE IN CHEMISTRY AND FIVE (5) YEARS OF PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE IN WATER OR WASTEWATER CHEMISTRY, TWO (2) YEARS OF WHICH MUST HAVE BEEN IN A SUPERVISORY CAPACITY; OR ANY COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(196A) MANAGER, SYSTEMS PROGRAMING. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY WITH MAJOR WORK IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION, ACCOUNTING, STATISTICS, MATHEMATICS OR ENGINEERING, FIVE (5) YEARS OF PROGRESSIVELY RESPONSIBLE EXPERIENCE IN DATA PROCESSING INCLUDING ANALYSIS DEVELOPMENT AND PROGRAMMING OF SYSTEMS METHODS AND PROCEDURES FOR CONVERSION TO COMPUTER PROCESSING TECHNIQUES, TWO (2) YEARS OF WHICH MUST HAVE BEEN IN A SUPERVISORY CAPACITY; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(226A) OPERATOR, PLANT, PRINCIPAL. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL, PREFERABLY TWO (2) YEARS OF COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN WATER OR WASTEWATER TECHNOLOGY, SIX (6) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN THE OPERATION OF WATER OR WASTEWATER PLANTS, TWO (2) YEARS OF WHICH MUST BE AT THE LEVEL OF SENIOR PLANT OPERATOR AND POSSESSION OF APPROPRIATE STATE OF MARYLAND LICENSES; OR ANY EQUIVALENT
