

COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

(B) BEGINNING [[JANUARY 15, 1975,]] DECEMBER 1, 1974 AND EACH [[JANUARY 15,]] OCTOBER 1, THEREAFTER, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF EACH VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT/COMPANY OR AMBULANCE CORPS SHALL FURNISH THE HARFORD COUNTY FIRE CHIEFS' ASSOCIATION A STATEMENT UNDER OATH CERTIFYING ALL VOLUNTEERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OR CORPS WHO HAVE QUALIFIED FOR CREDIT FOR THE PREVIOUS YEAR. EACH STATEMENT SHALL CONTAIN ALL MEMBERS' AGES AND PREVIOUS CREDITS EARNED AND OTHER INFORMATION AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE HARFORD COUNTY FIRE CHIEFS' ASSOCIATION, AND THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATION OF HARFORD COUNTY.

(C) UPON RECEIPT OF THIS STATEMENT, HARFORD COUNTY FIRE CHIEFS' ASSOCIATION SHALL REVIEW THE LIST OF EACH DEPARTMENT OR CORPS [[AND FURNISH A COPY THEREOF TO THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATION OF HARFORD COUNTY, TOGETHER WITH A CERTIFICATION AS TO THE ACCURACY OF EACH LIST BY MARCH 1, OF EACH YEAR]]. AFTER THE [[DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATION OF HARFORD COUNTY,]] HARFORD COUNTY FIRE CHIEF'S ASSOCIATION, APPROVES THE CERTIFIED LIST, [[HE]] THEY SHALL FORWARD A COPY OF EACH APPROVED LIST TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT/COMPANY OR AMBULANCE CORPS CONCERNED BY [[MARCH 15,]] NOVEMBER 1, OF EACH YEAR. THESE LISTS SHALL BE POSTED IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE WITHIN EACH FIRE DEPARTMENT/COMPANY OR AMBULANCE CORPS BUILDING FOR A PERIOD OF NOT LESS THAN THIRTY (30) CALENDAR DAYS. POSTING DATE SHALL BE NOTED ON ALL APPROVED LISTS AND THE DATE THE THIRTY (30) CALENDAR DAYS FOR A RIGHT OF APPEAL EXPIRES.

(D) A PERSON WHOSE NAME DOES NOT APPEAR ON THE CERTIFIED LIST, OR WHO IS DENIED CREDIT FOR SERVICES PRIOR TO JANUARY 1, [[1974]] 1975, [[HAS THE RIGHT TO APPEAL WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS FOLLOWING THE POSTING OF THESE LISTS.]] HAS THE RIGHT OF APPEAL WITHIN THIRTY (30) CALENDAR DAYS OF THE POSTING.

[[(E) THE APPEAL SHALL BE IN WRITING AND ADDRESSED TO THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF HARFORD COUNTY, WHO SHALL MAKE A FINAL DECISION. THE PERSON APPEALING MAY REQUEST A HEARING IN LIEU OF THE WRITTEN APPEAL. THE HEARING SHALL BE CONDUCTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF HARFORD COUNTY, MARYLAND, WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS OF THE REQUEST AND NOT LESS THAN FIVE (5) DAYS AFTER NOTIFYING THE APPELLANT OF THE DATE.]]

(E) THE REQUEST FOR AN APPEAL HEARING SHALL BE IN WRITING AND ADDRESSED TO THE HARFORD COUNTY FIRE CHIEF'S ASSOCIATION WHO SHALL MAKE A FINAL DECISION. THE HEARING SHALL BE CONDUCTED BY THE HARFORD COUNTY FIRE CHIEF'S ASSOCIATION WITHIN FIFTEEN (15) CALENDAR DAYS AFTER THE POSTING EXPIRES BUT NOT LESS THAN FIVE (5) CALENDAR DAYS AFTER NOTIFYING THE APPELLANT OF THE DATE.
