

COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

UNLESS ALL WORK FOR WHICH PERMITS HAVE BEEN ISSUED HAS BEEN FULLY COMPLETED AND HAS RECEIVED FINAL INSPECTION AND APPROVAL BY THE DEPARTMENT.

(G) THE DIRECTOR SHALL KEEP A REGISTER OF ALL LICENSES PLACED ON OR REMOVED FROM INACTIVE STATUS AND OF ANY MASTER ELECTRICIAN OR MASTER ELECTRICIAN LIMITED WHO CHANGES HIS AFFILIATION AS A QUALIFYING REPRESENTATIVE OF A PERSON, COMPANY, FIRM, CORPORATION OR PARTNERSHIP. A LICENSE PLACED ON THE INACTIVE LIST MAY BE RETURNED TO ACTIVE STATUS UPON CERTIFICATION BY THE BOARD AND UPON PROPER NOTIFICATION AND APPLICATION IN WRITING BY THE LICENSEE TO THE DEPARTMENT. ALL REQUIREMENTS OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE COMPLIED WITH BEFORE SAID LICENSE SHALL BE RESTORED TO ACTIVE STATUS BY THE DEPARTMENT.

(H) SUBJECT TO PROVISIONS IN SECTION 17-28 OF THIS CHAPTER, THE DEPARTMENT MAY RENEW LICENSES UNDER THIS CHAPTER TO ANY APPLICANT WHO AT THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT HELD AN EXISTING MONTGOMERY COUNTY ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE OR ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR'S LIMITED LICENSE.

17-26. LICENSES; DISPLAY AND DUPLICATES.

(A) ALL HOLDERS OF LICENSES ISSUED UNDER THIS CHAPTER SHALL DISPLAY THE LICENSE IN A PROMINENT PLACE AT THEIR BUSINESS LOCATION AND UPON DEMAND SHALL GIVE THE NUMBER OF THE LICENSE TO ANY INSPECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT.

(B) ALL HOLDERS OF MASTER ELECTRICIAN, MASTER ELECTRICIAN LIMITED, AND JOURNEYMAN ELECTRICIAN LICENSES SHALL HAVE IDENTIFICATION CARDS ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT IN THEIR POSSESSION AT ALL TIMES WHILE PERFORMING ELECTRICAL WORK WITHIN THE COUNTY AND SHALL DISPLAY SAME, UPON REQUEST, TO AUTHORIZED DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL.

(C) IF A LICENSE IS LOST, DEFACED OR DESTROYED, A LICENSEE IN GOOD STANDING MAY OBTAIN A DUPLICATE UPON FILING AN APPLICATION TO THE DIRECTOR AND PAYMENT OF THE COST OF REPLACEMENT.

17-27. APPRENTICE IDENTIFICATION CARD.

(A) ANY PERSON WHO DESIRES TO BE REGISTERED WITH THE COUNTY AS BEING ENGAGED IN A PROGRAM OF APPRENTICESHIP IN CONNECTION WITH HIS EMPLOYMENT WITH A LICENSED ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR, AS DEFINED BY THIS CHAPTER, MAY AT ANY TIME MAKE APPLICATION TO THE DIRECTOR ON FORMS PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

(B) THE DEPARTMENT, UPON PAYMENT OF A NON-REFUNDABLE FEE AS SET FORTH IN REGULATIONS PROMULGATED PURSUANT TO THIS CHAPTER, SHALL ISSUE TO THE
