tenant on such farm where feeding places are established, public highway or public building. Any residue in these containers for feeding purposes, and not devoured by the hogs, shall be disposed of by incineration, plowing under or burial within twenty-four hours after any one feeding. It shall be unlawful for trucks or other vehicles to transport trash or refuse to a dump or landfill from without the State of Maryland to within Prince George's County, unless authority has been granted by the [board of county commissioners.] COUNTY COUNCIL AND COUNTY EXECUTIVE.

(C) TRANSPORTATION OF SLUDGE. NO SLUDGE SHALL BE TRANSPORTED IN AND THROUGH PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL AND THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND, FOLLOWING THE RECEIPT OF COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER.

IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR TRUCKS OR ANY OTHER VEHICLES TO TRANSPORT SLUDGE FROM WITHOUT THE STATE OF MARYLAND AND/OR PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY TO WITHIN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY UNLESS AUTHORITY HAS FIRST BEEN GRANTED FOR SUCH TRANSPORT BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL AND THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY. THE COUNTY COUNCIL AND THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE SHALL HAVE AUTHORITY TO SET REASONABLE STANDARDS AND CONDITIONS REGULATING THE MOVEMENT OF SLUDGE INCLUDING THE MANNER OF ITS DISPOSAL, AND TO TERMINATE AND/OR ORDER CORRECTIONS FOR ANY OPERATIONS FOUND TO BE IN VIOLATION THEREOF.

- Licensing AND INSPECTION OF Vehicles. [(c)](D) All garbage transported over any public highway or street of Prince George's County to incinerators, approved [dumps,] WASTE **ACCEPTANCE** municipal FACILITIES. LANDFILLS, OR OTHER DISPOSAL SITES WITHIN THE COUNTY, or to destinations outside the limits of Prince George's County, shall be transported only in vehicles equipped with covered watertight, leak-proof bodies, or in metal containers with tight-fitting covers. The County Health Officer shall have the power and authority to ESTABLISH STANDARDS FOR, INSPECT, AND license the vehicles that are for the purpose of hauling the said garbage, and used each operator shall pay an annual license fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each vehicle used, the revenues from such licenses to be retained by the County Health Officer to defray the cost of inspection service for the enforcement of this section.
- [d] (E) Penalties. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than [five dollars (\$5.00)] ONE-HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) nor more than
