

## COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

(C) THE BOARD MAY CALL UPON AGENCIES OF THE STATE AND OTHER LOCAL GOVERNMENTS FOR STATISTICAL DATA, REPORTS, AND OTHER INFORMATION WHICH WILL ASSIST THE BOARD IN THE PERFORMANCE OF ITS DUTIES.

(D) APPOINTED MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SHALL SERVE TERMS OF THREE YEARS EXCEPT AS HEREINAFTER PROVIDED AND SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR REAPPOINTMENT. OF THE MEMBERS FIRST APPOINTED, THE ONE SELECTED FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC SHALL SERVE A TERM OF TWO (2) YEARS; ONE MANAGEMENT MEMBER AND ONE LABOR MEMBER SHALL SERVE A TERM OF ONE (1) YEAR EACH; AND THE OTHER TWO SHALL SERVE A TERM OF THREE (3) YEARS EACH. ANY VACANCIES OCCURRING IN ANY TERM SHALL BE FILLED BY APPOINTMENT OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE AS SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION 7-2 (A) ABOVE. THE MEMBERS SHALL BE COMPENSATED ON A PER DIEM BASIS AT THE RATE OF FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) PER DAY FOR EACH DAY OF SERVICE, NOT TO EXCEED TWO-THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,400.00) PER ANNUM.

(E) THE BOARD MAY EMPLOY PERSONS TO ASSIST IT IN THE PERFORMANCE OF ITS DUTIES TO THE EXTENT THAT MONEY IS APPROPRIATED IN THE BUDGET.

## 7-3 DETERMINATION OF PREVAILING WAGE RATE.

(A) THE BOARD IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND EMPOWERED TO ADOPT, ESTABLISH, REPEAL, MODIFY, CHANGE OR AMEND, FROM TIME TO TIME, SCHEDULES OF PREVAILING HOURLY RATES OF WAGES TO BE PAID TO WORKMEN AND APPRENTICES EMPLOYED ON PUBLIC WORKS, AS DEFINED IN SUBSECTION 7-1 (G); PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT THE SCHEDULES OF PREVAILING HOURLY RATE OF WAGES SO ESTABLISHED, SHALL BE REVIEWED BY THE BOARD AT LEAST ONCE EVERY YEAR AND SHALL BE REVISED TO CONFORM TO THE PREVAILING HOURLY RATE OF WAGES IN THE LOCALITY. SUCH SCHEDULES OF PREVAILING HOURLY RATE OF WAGES, INCLUDING THE PREVAILING RATE OF WAGES FOR OVERTIME WORK, SHALL BE NOT LESS THAN THE PREVAILING HOURLY RATE OF WAGES BEING PAID TO WORKMEN AND APPRENTICES FOR WORK OF THE SAME OR SIMILAR CHARACTER IN THE LOCALITY; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT IN NO EVENT SHALL THE PREVAILING RATE OF WAGES FOR OVERTIME WORK BE LESS THAN TIME AND A HALF THE BASIC HOURLY RATE OF PAY FOR STRAIGHT TIME. IF THERE IS NOT A SUFFICIENT NUMBER OF COMPETENT WORKMEN ENGAGED IN WORK OF THE SAME OR SIMILAR CHARACTER WITHIN THE LOCALITY, THE BOARD MAY USE THE NEAREST ESTABLISHED LOCATION FROM WHICH SUCH WORKMEN MAY BE OBTAINED IN SUFFICIENT NUMBERS TO PERFORM THE WORK TO MAKE THE DETERMINATION. THE BOARD SHALL FORTHWITH GIVE NOTICE BY MAIL OF ALL DETERMINATIONS OF PREVAILING WAGE RATES MADE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION TO ANY LABOR ORGANIZATIONS WHICH REQUEST THE BOARD TO DO SO. THE PUBLIC BODY SHALL SPECIFY IN THE CALL FOR BIDS FOR EVERY CONTRACT WHAT IS THE PREVAILING HOURLY RATE OF WAGES,
