

## COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY WITH ANY PUBLIC BODY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF ANY PUBLIC WORKS OR FROM PERFORMING ANY WORK ON THE SAME AS A CONTRACTOR OR SUB-CONTRACTOR FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR FROM THE DATE THE LIST IS FILED WITH THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS. NO PUBLIC BODY SHALL AWARD A CONTRACT FOR A PUBLIC WORKS TO ANY SUCH CONTRACTOR OR SUB-CONTRACTOR DURING THE ONE YEAR PERIOD. THE FILING OF THE LIST WITH THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS SHALL BE NOTICE TO ALL PUBLIC BODIES AND THEIR OFFICERS, OFFICIALS, MEMBERS, AGENTS AND REPRESENTATIVES.

## 7-10 RIGHT OF ACTION FOR WAGES

ANY WORKMAN OR APPRENTICE EMPLOYED BY THE CONTRACTOR OR ANY SUB-CONTRACTOR WHO IS PAID LESS THAN THE STIPULATED PREVAILING HOURLY WAGE RATES FOR WORK DONE UNDER THE CONTRACT, SHALL HAVE A RIGHT OF ACTION TO RECOVER THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE AMOUNTS SO PAID AND THE WAGE RATES PROVIDED BY THE CONTRACT, AND AN ACTION BROUGHT TO RECOVER SAME SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE A SUIT FOR WAGES, AND ANY AND ALL JUDGEMENTS ENTERED THEREIN SHALL HAVE THE SAME FORCE AND EFFECT AS OTHER JUDGMENTS FOR WAGES. IT SHALL NOT BE A DEFENSE TO SUCH AN ACTION THAT THE UNDERPAYMENTS WERE RECEIVED BY SAID WORKMAN OR APPRENTICE WITHOUT PROTESTS, EITHER ORAL OR IN WRITING, AGAINST THE AMOUNT THEREOF, AND THE LACK OR FAILURE OF PROTEST SHALL NOT BE A BAR TO RECOVERY OF THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE AMOUNTS PAID AND THE WAGE RATES PROVIDED BY THE CONTRACT.

## 7-11 RULES AND REGULATIONS

THE BOARD IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND EMPOWERED TO MAKE ANY AND ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS FROM TIME TO TIME, THAT MAY BE NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSES OF THIS ACT.

## 7-12 SEVERABILITY

IF ANY PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT, OR THE APPLICATION OF SUCH PROVISION TO ANY PERSON OR CIRCUMSTANCES, IS HELD INVALID, THE REMAINDER OF THIS ACT OR THE APPLICATION OF SUCH PROVISION TO PERSONS OR CIRCUMSTANCES OTHER THAN THOSE AS TO WHICH IT IS HELD INVALID, SHALL NOT BE AFFECTED THEREBY.
