14-903. KOSHER PREPARED FOOD.

A PERSON MAY NOT:

(1) WITH INTENT TO DEFRAUD, SELL OR PREPARE OR DISPLAY FOR SALE ANY FOOD, WHETHER FOR CONSUMPTION IN HIS PLACE OF BUSINESS OR IN ANOTHER PLACE, WHICH HE FALSELY REPRESENTS AS KOSHER;

(2) FALSELY REPRESENT TO THE PUBLIC THAT ANY FOOD SOLD OR OFFERED FOR SALE, WHETHER FOR CONSUMPTION IN HIS PLACE OF BUSINESS OR IN ANOTHER PLACE, IS OR WILL BE PREPARED AND SERVED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ORTHODOX JEWISH RELIGIOUS RULES AND REQUIREMENTS, BY:

(i) DISPLAYING A SIGN IN OR ABOUT HIS PLACE OF BUSINESS;

(ii) ADVERTISING IN ANY NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINE, OR OTHER PERIODICAL; OR

(iii) PUBLISHING IN ANY OTHER MANNER; OR

(3) PREPARE, SELL, SERVE, OR PREPARE FOR SALE, WHETHER FOR CONSUMPTION IN HIS PLACE OF BUSINESS OR IN ANOTHER PLACE, BOTH KOSHER AND NONKOSHER FOOD IN THE SAME PLACE OF BUSINESS, UNLESS HE:

(i) KEEPS SEPARATE KITCHENS AND DINING ROOMS FOR EACH TYPE OF FOOD;

(ii) KEEPS AND USES SEPARATE AND DISTINCTLY LABELED OR MARKED DISHES AND UTENSILS FOR EACH TYPE OF FOOD; AND

(iii) INCLUDES ON EACH SIGN AND DISPLAY ADVERTISEMENT IN OR ABOUT HIS PREMISES IN BLOCK LETTERS AT LEAST 4 INCHES HIGH THE WORDS "KOSHER AND NONKOSHER FOOD PREPARED AND SOLD HERE."
