16-202. CREATION OF LIEN.

(A) AIRCRAFT LIEN.

(1) ANY PERSON WHO, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE OWNER, HAS CUSTODY OF AN AIRCRAFT AND WHO, AT THE REQUEST OF THE OWNER, PROVIDES A SERVICE TO OR MATERIALS FOR THE AIRCRAFT, HAS A LIEN ON THE AIRCRAFT FOR ANY CHARGE INCURRED FOR ANY:

(i) INSPECTION, MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, SERVICING, OR REBUILDING;

(ii) STORAGE, PARKING, HANDLING, OR TIEDOWN;
OR

(iii) PARTS, ACCESSORIES, MATERIALS, OR SUPPLIES.

(2) THE OPERATOR OF ANY AIRPORT ON WHICH AN AIRCRAFT LANDS OR WHICH IS OTHERWISE USED BY AN AIRCRAFT HAS A LIEN ON THE AIRCRAFT FOR ANY LANDING FEE, FLIGHT FEE, OR OTHER CHARGE SO INCURRED.

(B) BOAT LIEN.

ANY PERSON WHO, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE OWNER, HAS CUSTODY OF A BOAT AND WHO, AT THE REQUEST OF THE OWNER, PROVIDES A SERVICE TO OR MATERIALS FOR THE BOAT, HAS A LIEN ON THE BOAT FOR ANY CHARGE INCURRED FOR ANY:

(1) REPAIR OR REBUILDING;

(2) STORAGE; OR

(3) PARTS OR ACCESSORIES.

(C) MOTOR VEHICLE LIEN.

ANY PERSON WHO, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE OWNER, HAS CUSTODY OF A MOTOR VEHICLE AND WHO, AT THE REQUEST OF THE OWNER, PROVIDES A SERVICE TO OR MATERIALS FOR THE MOTOR VEHICLE, HAS A LIEN ON THE MOTOR VEHICLE FOR ANY CHARGE INCURRED FOR ANY:

(1) REPAIR OR REBUILDING;

(2) STORAGE; OR

(3) TIRES OR OTHER PARTS OR ACCESSORIES.
