

(4) A JUDGMENT RENDERED IN EXCESS OF \$40,000 BECAUSE OF BODILY INJURY TO OR DEATH OF TWO OR MORE PERSONS AS THE RESULT OF ANY ONE ACCIDENT (SUBJECT TO THE LIMIT OF \$20,000 PER PERSON) IS SATISFIED IF \$40,000 HAS BEEN PAID ON THE JUDGMENT IN REDUCTION OF THE TOTAL JUDGMENT.

(5) A JUDGMENT RENDERED IN EXCESS OF \$5,000 BECAUSE OF INJURY TO OR DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY OF OTHERS AS A RESULT OF ANY ONE ACCIDENT IS SATISFIED IF \$5,000 HAS BEEN PAID ON THE JUDGMENT IN REDUCTION OF THE TOTAL JUDGMENT.

(B) PAYMENTS MADE IN SETTLEMENTS OF ANY CLAIMS BECAUSE OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE ARISING FROM THE ACCIDENT SHALL BE CREDITED IN REDUCTION OF THE AMOUNTS PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SECTION.

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(A) A JUDGMENT DEBTOR, UPON DUE NOTICE TO THE JUDGMENT CREDITOR, MAY APPLY TO THE COURT IN WHICH THE JUDGMENT WAS RENDERED FOR THE PRIVILEGE OF PAYING THE JUDGMENT IN INSTALLMENTS AND THE COURT, IN ITS DISCRETION AND WITHOUT PREJUDICE TO ANY OTHER LEGAL REMEDIES WHICH THE JUDGMENT CREDITOR MAY HAVE, MAY SO ORDER AND FIX THE AMOUNTS AND TIMES OF PAYMENT OF THE INSTALLMENTS.

(B) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT SUSPEND A LICENSE, REGISTRATION OR NONRESIDENT'S OPERATING PRIVILEGE, AND SHALL RESTORE ANY LICENSE, REGISTRATION OR NONRESIDENT'S OPERATING PRIVILEGE SUSPENDED FOLLOWING NONPAYMENT OF A JUDGMENT, IF THE JUDGMENT DEBTOR OBTAINS AN ORDER PERMITTING THE PAYMENT OF THE JUDGMENT IN INSTALLMENTS, AND WHILE THE PAYMENT OF ANY INSTALLMENTS IS NOT IN DEFAULT.

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IF THE JUDGMENT DEBTOR FAILS TO PAY ANY INSTALLMENT AS SPECIFIED BY THE ORDER, THEN UPON NOTICE OF THE DEFAULT, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL SUSPEND THE LICENSE, REGISTRATION OR NONRESIDENT'S OPERATING PRIVILEGE OF THE JUDGMENT DEBTOR UNTIL THE JUDGMENT IS SATISFIED, AS PROVIDED IN THIS ARTICLE, EXCEPT THAT AFTER DEFAULT, THE JUDGMENT DEBTOR MAY AGAIN APPLY, AFTER DUE NOTICE TO THE JUDGMENT CREDITOR, TO THE COURT WHICH ALLOWED INSTALLMENT PAYMENTS WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE DEFAULT FOR RESUMPTION OF THE PRIVILEGE OF PAYMENTS BY INSTALLMENTS, IF PAST-DUE INSTALLMENTS ARE FIRST PAID.
