

[(f)](E) The Department, through the Attorney General, may collect unpaid taxes provided for in this section in the same manner as other unpaid taxes due the State are collected. In addition, the Department may seize and hold any boat, truck, or other vehicle in which any oysters were or are transported until the taxes are paid.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
