SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 13-301 of Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1974 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

13-301.

To aid in the exercise of its rule-making powers, the Court of Appeals may appoint a standing committee of lawyers, [and] judges, AND OTHER PERSONS COMPETENT IN JUDICIAL PRACTICE, PROCEDURE OR ADMINISTRATION. A committee member shall serve without compensation, but shall be reimbursed for traveling and other expenses incurred on committee business.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
