times specified in § 12-201 of this article shall be equipped with at least one lamp displaying a white light visible from a distance of not less than 1000 feet to the front of the vehicle, and shall also be equipped with two lamps displaying red lights visible from a distance of not less than 1000 feet to the rear of the vehicle, or as an alternative, one lamp displaying a red light visible from a distance of not less than 1000 feet to the rear and two red reflectors visible from all distances of 600 to 100 feet to the rear when illuminated by the upper beams of head lamps.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT PURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
