(a) The provisions of this title are in addition and [supplement] SUPPLEMENTAL to all other provisions of the public general laws, the public local laws, and any local enactment in the state.

(c) In proceeding under Article III of the Constitution of the state, or any amendment to it, the plaintiff shall pay interest at the rate of 6 percent per annum on any difference between the amount of money initially paid into court for the use of the defendant and the jury award as stated in the inquisition, [as of] FROM the date the money was paid into court [and] TO the date of the inquisition or final judgment, whichever DATE is later.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
