General Fund Appropriation.....	4,000,000
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SEC. 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That in order to carry out the provisions of these appropriations the Secretary of Budget and Fiscal Planning is authorized:

(a) To allot all or any portion of the funds herein appropriated to the various departments, boards, commissions, officers, schools and institutions by monthly, quarterly or seasonal periods and by objects of expense and may place any funds appropriated but not allotted in contingency reserve available for subsequent allotment. Upon his own initiative or upon the request of the head of any State agency, the Secretary may authorize a change in the amount of funds so allotted. The Secretary shall before the beginning of the fiscal year file with the Comptroller of the Treasury his schedule of allotments, if any. The Comptroller shall not authorize any expenditure or obligation in excess of the allotment made and any expenditure so made shall be illegal.

(b) To allot all or any portion of funds coming into the hands of any department, board, commission, officer, school and institution of the State, from sources not estimated or calculated upon in the budget.

(c) To fix the number and classes of positions or man years of authorized employment for each agency, unit or program thereof, not inconsistent with the Public General Laws in regard to classification of positions. He shall file his determinations with the Secretary of Personnel and the Comptroller of the Treasury before the beginning of the fiscal year and no payment for salaries or wages nor any request for or certification of
