Baltimore &c To all persons to whom this shall come Greeting in our Lord God our everlasting
know ye that as it appears in the Records for the said Remaining in our Secret
Secretarys office that by grant under the great Seale of our said Province of Maryland
bearing date the thirteenth day of January in the eight and twentieth year of the
reign of our Dear Father Charles of noble memory King Anno Domini in thousand
six hundredes fifty and nine ^{was given} unto Capt Thomas Howel one of the Justices of the Peace
of the said Province the South side of a tract called Henders Creek containing six hundred Acres more or
less and the said Thomas Howel as we are informed having surreptitiously obtained
a patent for the said parcel of land contrary to the conditions of plantation of our
said Father was given to our Sheriff of Calvert County that by good and lawfull men of this
County with the usual knowen to the Sheriff of the said Thomas Howel or to the Sheriff
of James Brown late deceased that they should appear before us in our said Court
of Calvert the fourth day of April the fourth day of April Anno Domini one thousand
six hundredes fawenty six to show cause if any they had why the said Letters Patents
of the said aforesaid ought not to be Revo^d and Annulled and the same into our
hands be delivered and further to do and Receive what our said Court shall do or grant
to be done in this behalf And how he should execute this our Precept that he with knowen
to our said Court the day aforesaid At which said fourth day of April in the year aforesaid
the said Sheriff under Return of the writ aforesaid returned the one and thirtieth day of
March one thousand six hundredes fawenty six that by virtue thereof he had warred the Regis
of Cap^t Thomas Howel duly created But for the Regis of James Brown could not be found within his
County at which said fourth day of April the Regis of the said Thomas Howel came not but under
default and afterwards to wit the eleventh day of the same April our said Court being informed and fully
satisfied that the said grant is surreptitiously obtained ^{so contrary} contrary to the conditions of plantation of our
said late Father Charles of noble memory And therefore did order that our Dear Uncle Phillip
Calvert Esq^r our Chamberlain of our said Province of Maryland should create the aforesaid
Patent upon Records and did adjudge the said land to be and of Right ought to be seized in our
Right Now know ye ^{that} the writ for and in consideration of the full quantity of twenty five
thousand pounds of tobacco to us in hand paid by Richard Putter in Calvert County in our said
Province of Maryland the Receipt whereof we do hereby Acknowledge Do Grant unto
