 fourth day of May in the second year of the Dominion of the Right Honourable  
 Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Province of Maryland and Annapolis  
 Lord Baron of Baltimore &c annoq<sup>o</sup> Domini one thousand six hundred & seventy  
 six

The condition of this present about written obligation is such that if the above bounden Thomas  
 Marsh his Executors Administrators and assigns shall and do well and truly  
 hold observe perform fulfill and observe all and every the covenants, gifts, grants, articles  
 clauses and agreements mentioned and contained in our Indenture of bargain, and sale, of the  
 date of these presents about written and made by and between the said Thomas Marsh of the one  
 parts, and the above named Thomas Sterling of the other part, within in the parts and behalf of the  
 said Thomas Marsh his Executors Administrators and assigns and ought to be holden observe perform  
 fulfill and do according to the true intent and meaning of the said Indenture and especially in all  
 points and contents that then this present about written obligation shall be void and of no effect  
 otherwise to stand and remain in full power force strength and virtue

 holden before us in the Chamber of the Guildhall of the said City personally came and appeared James Glavin  
 of Jersey Junr. Land near the City of London in the County of Middlesex aged sixty years or thereabouts being a person well  
 known and worthy of good faith and credit did by his solemn Oath which he took upon the holy Evangelists  
 of Almighty God in the presence and request of Thomas Glavin of Lymington in the County of Hampshire Gentleman  
 before us then and there solemnly declare testify and depose to be true that the said James Glavin is the  
 reputed naturall and legitimal son of the said Bartholomew Glavin late of Maryland  
 in Virginia (surgeon deceased) which this deposition doth to be true because he is the father of the said James Glavin  
 and was once Brother to the said Thomas Glavin of Lymington aforesaid. Wherein the said James Glavin and
