 me, by the said Edward Gibbs, or by any other person or persons whatsoever whom it may concern
 either by bill, bond, book account, or otherwise, for any matter or cause whatsoever, or by any other way or
 means whatsoever, giving and hereby granting unto my said attorney, full power, good right, and lawfull
 authority, in the premises, him the said Edward Gibbs and all other persons whatsoever whom it may concern,
 to please, sue, hear, defend, declare, implore, implore, sue to be returned, and out of prison to deliver,
 Attorney of also and or more under him to sue, and fulfill, and the same against to revoke, and generally
 to do and execute, all such way or ways and means, for the recovery of the said premises, either by suite or
 execution in as large and ample manner as I my self might personally do the same, ratifying allowing
 confirming, all and whatsoever my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done in the premises, by

This Indenture made the fourth day of March in the year of our Lord God one thousand
 six hundred seventy eight betweene Henry Fox of the County of Saint Marys in
 the Province of Maryland Gent of the one part and Edward Ward of the same
 County and Province Gentleman of the other part Whereas the second day of March
 in the year of our Lord 1650 one Edward Chace late of the said County deceased as
 Guardian to the said Henry Fox ratified to be divided for a certain writt of partition
 on the 6. day of the said Henry Fox ten partnership and undivided betweene one
 Sule Barber Dog deceased and the said Henry Fox of a certain piece of land
 lying upon Brittons Bay in the said County the said writt of partition was duly
 executed and returned hereof made number of hands and halves of the same
 heretofore summoned Impanelled and sworn as appears in the Records of the
 Provinciall Court of the said Province and County of the said County of the
 said heretofore annexed the said Moyety or half part thereof to hold to him the said
 witnesseth that the said Henry Fox has hereof assigned for ever to hold to him the said
 and just quantity of six thousand five hundred and in consideration of the foresaid
 Tobacco in part to him in hand at and before the Insisting and Delivery hereof by
 the said Edward Ward were and being contented satisfied and paid as for divers other good
 and valuable causes and considerations him the said Henry Fox heretofore especially movem
 that granted bargained sold Enfranchised and confirmed and by this presents sold
 grant bargain sold Enfranchise and confirmed unto the said Edward Ward all that
 Moyety or half part of the said piece or parcel of Land soe divided out as
 by the said partition appears (in buying by estimation seven hundred acres more or less
 together with all houses out houses, Woods Underwoods Barren, Fields Out Cares
 Gardens Offices and buildings what soever, Rayall Mynds excepted) to the James
 William and Whiting the the same belonging either alone or together with other the
 Land of the said Henry Fox or true Copies of the same to be Copied and
 taken out at the
