 Lord Mayor and the Aldermen or Senate of the City of London send greeting KNOW YEE that on
 the day of the date hereof in the Kings Majesties Court holden before us in the Chamber of the
 Guild Hall of the said City personally came and appeared Thomas Luckett of London aforesaid
 Writer aged ffeare and thirty years by theseabouts Being a person well knowne and worthy
 of good faith and credit and did by his Solemn Oath which he tooke upon the holy Evangelists
 of Rightly God before us therand there solemnly declare Testify and depose to bee true
 at the request of Robert Hawkins of London Roapmacher that he was present
 and did see William Dunkerton signe Scale and as his Act and Deed deliver to god for
 the use of the Requirant Robert Hawkins a certaine Originaled Deed Indented and made
 the Two and Twentieth day of September Anno Domini 1675 And in the Seaven and
 Twentyneth year of his Majesties Regne that now is, Betwene the said William
 Dunkerton by the name of William Dunkerton late of Baltimore County in the
 Province of Maryland now neare Virginia and then of London Merchant of the
 One partie And the said Robert Hawkins by the name of Robert Hawkins late
 of the said County and Province and now of London Roapmacher of the other partie
 purporting his the said William Dunkertons Mortgaging of sundry Lands in
 Baltimore County aforesaid for and in Consideracion of the better security and
 more sure payment to be made to the said Robert Hawkins of the summe of One
 hundred and thirtie pounds of Lawfull money of England by him owing to the said
 Robert Hawkins according as mad by the said Deed is more at large exprest and that
 he this Deponent as a witness to such the said William Dunkertons Signeing sealing and
 delivery of the said Deed did sett his forme On the back side thereof as by the same
 appears in ch Deed was this day producde to this Depon^t Whole and Uncoufelle In
 Faith and Testimony whereof betweene the said Lord Mayor and Aldermen the Seal of
 the Office of Mayoraltie of the said City of London to these presents have caused
 to bee putt and appened And the said Original produced Deed and a procuracy
 or Letter of attorney firmed by William Scory who is a Notary publicke fact
 fully Legall and of trust by his Majes^t authority admitted and sworne dwelling
 in this City to bee seruants armes dated in London the thirteenth day of September
 Anno Domini 1676 And in the eight and twentyneth year of the Regne of our
 Sovereigne Lord Charles the second King of England &c.

By this Publick Instrument of Procuracy or Letter of Attorney beeit
 knowne and manifest unto all people that On the thirteenth day of the Month of September
 Anno Dom 1676 And in the eighth and twentyneth year of the Regne of our Sovereigne
 Lord Charles the second by the Grace of God King of England Scotland France and
 Ireland Defend by her faith & before me William Scory Notary & Tabellion
 publick by authority of our said Sovereigne Lord the King admitted and sworne
 dwelling in this City of London and in the presence of the witness above named
 personally appeared Robert Hawkins of London aforesaid Roapmacher and hath
 made vidame and in his stead and place hath put and constated and by these
 presents doth make ordaine and in his stead and place doth putt and constate M^r W^m
 Date of the Province of Maryland Merchant at present in London the bearer hereof
 his true and lawfull attorney giving unto him full power authority and speciall charge
 for and in the name and to the use of him his Constituant to aske demand leavie recover
 and receive of land from William Dunkerton of the said Province of Maryland
 Merchant or his heires executors or admisors such other person or persons whome
 it of Right doth or may concern The summe of One hundred and thirtie pounds
 of Lawfull Money of England w^{ch} the said William Dunkerton doth owe and is
 indected to the said Constituant as may appear by a certaine Deed made
 Between them and dated the two and twentyneth day of September 1675 Together
 with all oys Damages and Interests. And by the w^{ch} Deed the said William
 Dunkerton having assigned and Mortgaged sundry lands in Baltimore County
 in the Province of Maryland for and in Consideracion of the better security &
 more sure payment to be made to the said Robert Hawkins of the said summe
 of One hundred and thirtie pounds in manner and forme as in the said Deed is
 expressed The said Constituant doth therefore by vertue hereof give power &
 authorise his said Attorney upon default of payment of the said Money to
 enter upon and take possession of all and every the lands made over for security
 By the said Deed as afores-
