 Gerard of Westwood in the County of St Maryes in the said Province of Maryland Gentle  
 of the one party And the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Thomas Kelly of Wicoromico River in the said County  
 of St Maryes in the said Province of Maryland Esq<sup>r</sup> of the other party Witnesses that where-
