Memorandum That this present day to wit the undated Twentie day of May in
fourth year of the Dominion of the Right Hon^eble Charles Lord Baltimore
now alsoe Lord and Proprietary of the said Province of Maryland &c in pursuance
of a certaine remeved Order of the pro^{xy} Court of the same Province held at City of St
Marys and dated the thirteenth day of October last past before the date hereof
for Continuall of former and Oryginall Order here before that made for One whole
yearre longer in a certaine Case in the same Court depending betweene Mary Roe
ex^q Edward Roe Gent Deced^d of the one part and John Ingram of the other
part touching a certaine Attachment ther^e Granted to the said Mary and in part —
executed on certaine Bills and accountes belonging to the estate of the said Ingram
she the said Mary Roe had principall together with William Combes and George
Cowley Gent as Sureties of and for her the said Mary came before me Henry Curtey
one of his said Lordships Counsell of Law and for the said Province and one of the
Justices of the said Court and personally acknowledged themselves jointly and
each of them severally to owe and bee due unto his Lordship in the summe summe
of seaven hundred pounds Sterling to bee paid to his said Lordship his heire Successors
or assigned at the first of the birth of our Lord Christ now nexte Considering the date hereof
and they the said Recognizors awilling and for themselves and each of them and for
theire and each of their heires Executors and Administrators to bee and doe jointly and
severally bound by these presents that in case of default shall be made in payment
of the said summe in forme aforesaid for that the same summe of seaven hundred
pounds Sterling or the full value ther^e to be levied had and recovered of
the several and respective Mans Mewmages Lands Tenure goods Chattells and
hereditaments of them the said Mary Roe William Combes and George Cowley their
several and respective heires Executors and Administrators or somone any on either of
them whereover they shall or may be found by vertue of these presents

Whiche destance and upon Indication never to loose according to the tenor prop-
er intent of the abovesigned Original and received order on behalf of Court that in
the abovesaid provinciall Court and all and every the members of the same shall from
time to time and at all times be sufficiently hindimpined against all actions and suits
on other matters that shall or may happen touching or concerning the abovesigned
attainment or the Granting or making the said order or renewing thereof, theron And
that Iohn the above bounden Mary Roe her Executors adms^t assignes or somone or
off them doe or shall make retencion of the Bills afo^r and other parts and parcels
of the estate of the abovesigned John Ingram vassal by vertue of the said attainment or the
value thereof respectively in proportion In case the said J^r Ingram or his Attorney do^r shall
within a Year and a day to be appointed from the abovesaid fifteenth day of Octo^r last past before
the date of the Recognizant above written bring the summe of the summe of the
the said order for one and long as above written and make this said therin say^r order
deft and proceed of in the aforesaid aecⁿ in due and assesse or common forme likew^r make
it appear that she the said Mary is satisfied of and for her selfe demands in part or in full that then
the said Recognizant above written specified acknowledg^d and uttered into forme above said shall
take and attaint and br^en^r utterly by a Oath or Conscience in full forme before
