Then Alexander Draper made & hath before us that he is deprived of the within mentioned land by virtue
of another letter of an older date

I witness before me William Stourns

Witnesses his within mentioned Alexander Draper hath been deprived of the land made over unto him by
this Conyngton by an older letter of John Studer he hath thought fit to grant at & do hereby grant
unto the said Draper liberty to take up the quantity of two hundred acres of land where he shall think
fit to take the same which under my hands this twenty eighth October One thousand six hundred and severally

Know all men by these presents that John Penroy of Deptford ward London Maryn
have assigned ordained and made and my seal and placed put and constituted my trusty and
well beloved Brother Thos Penroy late of Saint Pauls in Upper Shadwell in London and now
of Saint Marys County in the Province of Maryland Attorney to carry try and Law full
attorney for me and in my name and to my use to affect judgment recovery and Recovery of
all and every person and persons whatsoever where the said prohibited and every just
debt due tobacco sum and sum of money goods wares and Merchandise as are now due
unto me or will at any day or days hereon sum herafter shall be due owing belonging
or pertaining unto me by any manner of way or means what so ever giving & granting
unto my said Attorney by the power of these presents my full and whole power strength
and authority in and about the premises, and upon receipt of any such debts due tobacco sum
or sum of money goods wares and Merchandise as aforesaid acquittances or otherwise discharged
for me and in my name to make sealed deliver and all and every other part thing
and things done and delivered in the law what so ever used full power to be done
in or about the premises for the recovery of any just debt due tobacco sum or sum of
money goods wares and Merchandise as aforesaid for me and in my name to do and cause to be done
as fully largely and amply in every respect to all intent and purpose
as my selfe or he could do of his own personally present Ratifying & having holding
fixed and sealed all and what so ever my said attorney shall lawfully do on cause to be done
in or about the premises of the said by virtue of this power given in writing witness whereupon I have
hereunto set my hand and seal the second day of May in the year of our Lord god 1679
