In the ^{barren} side of a Deed of Conveyance of two hundred acres of land called Saint Lukes lying in
Transylvania being in Rowan County sold by George Anderson unto Alexander Draper
was thus written (viz)

February 24th 1679

Then Alexander Draper made Oath before me that he is deprived of the within mentioned Land by Virtue
of another Grant out of an older date
Sworn before me William Stouens

Whereas the within mentioned Alexander Draper hath been deprived of the Land made over unto him by
this Conveyance by an older Grant out of John Anderson I have thought fit to grant as I do hereby grant
unto the said Draper liberty to take up the quantity of two hundred Acres of said Land he shall think
fit to take the same year under my hand this twentieth October and thousand six hundred & seventy
nine

Do this at St Marys or in
his absence to Mr Nicholas Lainton

Know all men by these presents that John Penroy of Deptford ward London Maryn
have assigned ordained and made and in my hand and seal put and constituted my trusty and
well beloved Brother Thomas Penroy late of Saint Pauls in upper Shadwell in London and now
of Saint Margret County in the Province of Maryland Merchant to be my true and Law full
attorney for me and in my name and to my use to take sue recover and receive of
all and every person and persons whatsoever within the said Province all and every just
debts due tobacco fund and funds of money goods wares and Merchandize as and now due
unto me or wch at any day or days here or hereafter shall be due owing belonging
or appertaining unto me by any manner of wayes or means what so ever Giving power Granting
unto my said Attorney by the tenor of these presents my full and whole power strength
authority in and about the premises and upon receipt of any due debts due tobacco fund
or funds of money goods wares or Merchandize as aforesaid acquittances or other discharges
for me and in my name to make sale and deliver and all and every other act or thing
and things doings and deeds in the Law what so ever necessary to be done
in or about the premises for the recovery of any just debts due tobacco fund or funds of
money goods wares or Merchandize as aforesaid for me and in my name to do execute
perform as fully largely and amply in every respect to all intents constructions and purposes
as I my self might or could do if I were personally present Ratifying a holding holding
firm and stable all and whatsoever my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done
in or about the premises of the said by virtue of these presents In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal the second day of May in the year of our Lord god 1679
