Upon the humble petition of Sarah Calvert and Younger this day exhibited to the Court sheweth by  
setting forth that William Calvert her late husband decessed by his last Will and Testament, made the  
said Sarah Calvert his wife sole Ex<sup>or</sup>, and that by devise to her and her heires a certain peice of  
Land called Daylys desire lying in Queenes County containing five hundred acres, and in October in the  
year of our Lord One thousand six hundred forty five was accidentally killed by the Indians  
at the place knowne as Fort, after his death and Alexander Younger pretending himself to be a  
person free to marry being a widow when she was the petitioner to marry him, and they being married  
accordingly the said Alexander Younger possessed himself of all the personall estate then in the petitioner  
possession, some part whereof belonged to the petitioner's children, and disposed thereof to his owne  
use, and not only soe but did, by threats and undue practices persuade the petitioner to consent  
to settle the said Land on Charles Butler gent as a Trustee for the use of the said Alexander  
Younger and his heires, and the said Charles Butler did convey the said Land to the said Alexander and  
his heires, and by soe to enable him to sell and dispose of the said Land, and did shipp him self with the personall  
personall estate for England leaving the petitioner and her children utterly ruined, but before he  
could sell the said Land the said Sarah hearing where the said decessed lay proceeded an Order of this Court  
to have the said Land found in the peritarget office to preserve the said Land from being sold, she having  
received information that the said Alexander had another wife in England then a free living, and she  
the said Sarah now producing two affidaves to two Justices where by it appeared the said Alexander had  
at the time of the said Marriage a wife in England then and long after living and free living  
therefore she prayed, that the said Deeds may be delivered up to be cancelled, and that she may  
Remayne as in her former Right as Widow of the said William Calvert and may have power to  
sell and dispose thereof as she shall thinke fitt for the maintenance of herselfe and her children, and that the  
petitioner's petitioning of the said Alexander's wife were thereby of opinion if the said Marriage between  
the said Alexander Younger and the said Sarah was Null and void, and that therefore order that the said Deeds be  
delivered up to be cancelled, and that the Curulem or other duty & acknowledgements thereof be  
Vacated upon the Record, and that the said Sarah Remayne the proper owner thereof
