Maryland Memorandum August 4th 1679

Sheweth that I the said Vincent Low Deputy Surveyor of
Talbot County to Execute a certain Warrant of Walter Nelson for which he had now
produced returns by which he had as thereby appears Right to Eighteen hundred acres of
land to be taken up at or in any place or places within the Province, And first in case the
said Walter shall be willing and desirous to have the said Warrant to be executed
by laying forth of land in part or in full on the South side of Great Chaptank River
or Elsewhere out of the precept bound of yo Deputy Surveyors Shipp, That yo execute
just and Right in this behalf only, but not to be drawn into precept or at any
other time by you proceeded without special Warrant under my hand and seal, and for
your Acting in this present behalf as above specified according to the said and duty
of a Surveyor this shall be your special and sufficient Warrant Given under my
hand and seal the day and year above Written Vincent Low (Sealed)
