 The Condition of this obligation is such that whereas Richard Mitford of the County of Saint Marys above said widow hath by her deed of Gift bearing even date herewith Given and Granted a parcel of Ground Whereon she now lieth containing by estimation one hundred acres with the appurtenances, to the use and behoof of Thomas and Joseph Mitford her children as therein doth appear, and whereas also the said Richard hath in the said deed of Gift given and Granted to the said Richard Mitford in Trust for the use and behoof of her said children two Cows to be kept with all their female Offspring, and whereas also there is a Marriage Intending to be shortly had and solemnized between the said Marmaduke Sumner and Richard Mitford, It therefore the above bounden Marmaduke Sumner shall not from time to time or at any time hereafter Commit or cause to be committed or done any waste or destruction in or upon the said granted parcel of Land or any the said granted premises in the said deed granted, Contrary to the true intent and meaning of the said Deed of Grant, and also if the said Marmaduke Sumner do or shall at the next Provinceall Court to be holden for the said Province Give and Grant the said Richard Mitford full power and authority (as if he were sole) to acknowledge in open Court the said deed of Grant to be his Deed and Deeds, and the said acknowledgment to stand remain and be in full force according to the true intent and meaning of the said Deed as therein is expressed, any Law Usage or Custom to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding, That then this obligation to be void or else to stand in full force and virtue
