Do command you that the Record and process of the said Judgment with all things touching the same before our Justices of our Provinceall Court to be held at our City of Saint Maries the Eighth day of October next under your hands & seals distinctly and openly you send that Inspection being had of the Record and proceedings therein we may cause further to be done what of Right and according to the Lawes & Constitutions of this Province ought to be done therein, And that you have here this writt Witness our selfe at our City of Saint Maries the Twentieth day of September in the fourth year of our Dominion &c Anno Domini One thousand six hundred seventy nine

At which said Eighth day of October in the year aforesaid The Comiss<sup>rs</sup> of the said Saint Maries County Court do his Lordships Justices of the Provinceall Court at the City of Saint Maries the Transcript of the Records of the proceedings & Judgment of the said Saint Maries County Court have sent, according as by the said writt they were Comanded, and so the hand of the Clerke of the said Court the bond Robert Holloway in these words (Viz)

Maryland's Charles a bolett Lord and Proprietary of the Province of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c do the sherriff of Saint Maries County greeting we command you that ye take the body of Richard Walker and him safe keepe so that you have the body before our Justices of our County Court to be held at New town on the first Tudday in August next to answer unto Thomas Lomas in a plea of trespass on the Case, whereof saile not at your perill and have you here this writt, Given under the seale of our said County the seventh day of June in the third year of our Dominion &c Anno Domini One thousand six hundred seventy eight ~ ~ Vera Copia John Manley Clerk

Whereupon the said Thomas Lomas in his own proper person sayth that Whereas the said Richard Hart stands indebted to him for Attorneys fees the sum of seven hundred pounds of Tobacco as by acct<sup>s</sup> here in Court produced will more plainly appear, & Whereas the said Richard Walker some time in the Month of February or March One thousand six hundred seventy seven, did by sending the said Richard Hart his Boate transport the said Hart out of this Province to the dettroying and defrauding of his Creditors of their Just dues contrary to an Act of Assembly in that behalf made and provided made Anno One thousand six hundred seventy four; And although the said Thomas the said sum of seven hundred hundred pounds of Tobacco of him the said Richard Walker hath often demanded yett he hath not paid &c
