 and therupon ^{being the 15th day of Septembre} And the said Rose and John Gerard by Invent Lw thys Attorney come & P And
 say they are not bound by the law to hold Covenant with the said Thomas and Abou
 it against them supposed for that the said Rose and John haue paid and are
 Engagis by bill to pay Out the said Estate of Thomas Gerard Esq Decreasid more
 then the personall Estate of him the said Thomas Decreasid doe amount unto And haue
 or will come to thys hand as Exects of him the said Thomas Decreasid And of
 this they putt themselves upon the Country And the said Thomas saith that he Ought not
 to be debarred from halving his Deed aforesaid against them the said Rose Gerard
 and John Gerard for that he saith that they the said Rose and John haue not fully
 Administris and payed Out of the Estate of the said Thomas Gerard Decreasid nor
 are indebted by debts of a higher natura beyond what shottis are come to the hands
 of them the said John and Rose And of this he putt himself upon the Country and the
 Defendants likewise Therefor command is given to the Sheriff of St Marye's County that
 he cause to come here Two dayes & by whom & who neither & because as well & to Recognize
 Now herde att this day to wit the fifteenth day of September in the forty third year of the
 Dominion of Cecilius & came the said Thomas Gerard by his Attorney and the said

 County that of the good Chattells or Creditts late of Thomas Gerard Esq Decreasid if
 they should be found in his Balyn with his cause to be made ad wth the summe of
 Thirti fyve Thousand pounds of Tobato A certaine Debt Recovered against John Gerard
 and Rose Gerard Exects of the last will and Testament of the said Thomas Gerard
 Esq by Thomas Gerard Gentl at A Provinciall Court held att the City of St Marye's the
 fifteenth day of September now last past whereof they are Convict ad also the summe of
 Two thousand and eight pounds of Tobato more for his Costs and Chargis in that behalfe
 laid Out and expended and when he had the same so made or any part therof the
 same to deliuer to the said Thomas Gerard or his Deed And that he make knowne
 to his Lordships Justices here of the extintion of the same with Now herde att this day
 to wit the fourteenth day of May in the three and fortyeth year of the Dominion of
 Cecilius & the same Sheriff maketh returne of the writ aforesaid that he hath
 Executed of the creditts late of Thomas Gerard Esq Decreasid the summe of four hundre
 hundred pounds of Tobato being part of the said sume wherupon the said Thomas
 Gerard by Robert Carnile his Attorney then preyed an Elegit against the goodd and
 chattells land & tenement for the remainder of the Deb & Costs aforesaid according
 to the forme of the Statute in that case made and Provided And it is Granted unto him
