

Maryland Memorandum

That on the Twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand six hundred seventy eight came William Plummer by Christopher Rous by his Attorney before the Hon^{ble} Phillip Calvert Esq^r Chancellour of this Province of Maryland And prayes his Lordshippes Writ of Error to him the said William to be granted to his Lordshippes Justices of the County Courts of Somerset County to be directed, to require him to send before his Lordshippes Justices of the Provinciaall Court, the Record proceedings and Judgment of the said County Court in a certain Cause there late depending, Betwene one Amos Parsons plaintiff, and the said William Plummer Defendant in an Action of Trespass upon the Case, and it is Granted unto him the said Writ of Error in these words (Viz)

Charles absolute Lord and Prop^r of the Province of Maryland and Chevalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c, do our Commissioners of Somerset County greeting Because in the Record and proceed^{ings} of the Just^{ices} of Amos Parsons manifest Error hath happened, to the greate damage of the said William Plummer, as by the greate Complaint of the said William We have received, We willing that the Error (if any be) should in due manner be corrected, and full and speedy Justice to be done to the said parties in this behalf, do remand you that the Record and proceed^{ings} of the said Judgment, wth all things pertaining thereto be sent before our Justices of our Provinciaall Court to be held at our City of Saint Marys the third day of June next, upon your hands and sealed distinctly and openly you send, that Inspection being had of the Record proceedings therein We may cause further to be done what of right and according to Lawes & Constitucions of this Province ought to be done therein, and that you have the said writ Witness our selfe at our City of Saint Marys the twentieth day of March in the fourth year of our Dominion &c Amos Dominij One thousand six hundred seventy eight

And at the said time his Lordshippes writ of Error facias was Issued to the said Amos Parsons in these words following (Viz)

Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Province of Maryland and Chevalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c to our Sheriffe of our County of Somerset greeting, Because in the Record & proceed^{ings} as also at the Just^{ices} of Amos Parsons, Manifest Error hath happened to the greuous damage of the said William Plummer as out of his Complaint We have accepted, the Record and proceed^{ings} of w^{ch} said Judgment before our Justices of our Provinciaall Court to be held at our City of Saint Marys the third day of June next, We have caused to be sent, and we being willing the Error (if any be) should in due manner be corrected, and full and speedy Justice to be done to the said parties, We command you that by Lawfull and honest men of your Baronshippe you make knowen to the said Amos Parsons, that hee bee before our Justices of our Provinciaall Court at the day and place aforesaid to hear the Record aforesaid if to him it shall seeme Expedient, and further to shew to and abide what our said Court shall consider of in that behalf, and that you from further taking molesting and unreasoning or him the said William Plummer by that occasion any waies molesting you altogether justes, and if him the said William Plummer for that occasion and no other you have taken him wth out delay you set at large, and have ye the said writ Witness our selfe at our City of Saint Marys the twentieth day of March in the fourth year of our Dominion &c Amos Dominij One thousand six hundred seventy eight

At w^{ch} said third day of June the said Justices of Somerset County read returned of the said writ of Error facias in these words (Viz) By Thomas Williams and James H. Handy good and Lawfull men of my Baronshippe I have made knowen to the w^{ch} in name Amos Parsons, Geo. Walker the
