That a County Court held the twelfth day of March in the third year of the Dominion of the Right Honorable Charles Lord Baltimore over Maryland the Shmo parson One thousand six hundred seventy seven by his Lordships Justices hereto assigned and Authorized

Shomsett County is William Plummer ad i' attorney of Matthew Nelson was summoned to shew unto Shmo parson in a plea of Trespass upon the Case that he the said Nelson upon the six and twentieth day of October in the first year of the Dominion of Charles Lord Baltimore the Shmo parson One thousand six hundred seventy seven bargained and agreed to and with the plaintiff from the six and twentieth day of October till the last day of February to serve him the said Nelson for twelve hundred pounds of Tobacco and Cash, and the said Nelson did oblige himself to bring the said Shmo parson to Shmammehop River the first of March following, but the said aforesaid Nelson him the said parson carried over the bay, and when he heard that the said Nelson had agreed for was expired, he the said parson did require the said Nelson to perform his bargain and carry him home, but the said Nelson did refuse the said, and would not let him the said parson leave his premises but kept him there his Bookkeeper till the last day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand six hundred seventy seven, for with future force there is due to the plaintiff sixteen hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco with funds amount to two thousand eight hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco, of which the said Nelson hath paid the plaintiff One thousand four hundred and six pounds and one half of a pound of Tobacco and remained still due to the plaintiff One thousand four hundred forty three pounds and one half of a pound of Tobacco, which the said Nelson when Exault in the County doings to pay the said, although often hereto required, and since William Plummer his attorney hath denied and still doth to pay the said and free doth to pay the said fund of One thousand four hundred forty three pounds and one half of a pound of Tobacco with the said Loss and Dammage Two thousand and hundred and ninety pounds of Tobacco therefore he brought this suit against William Plummer the attorney of Matthew Nelson
