Now all men by these presents by these presents that John England of the City of Bristol March, have Granted Authority deputed and appointed, and in my place and stead doe put and constitute Robert Rogoly of St Marys County in the Province of Maryland Gentleman my true and Lawfull Attorney for me and in my name and to my use to aske demand receive and recover of and from all and every person and persons in Virginia and Maryland all and every such summe and summes of money and every person and persons in Virginia and Maryland all and every such summe and summes of money goods wares Merchandises debts dues and demands whatsoever in and or shall be to mee due owing or in any wise belonging either by bill bond specialty Bookes fees account Receipting or otherwise howsoever Giving and hereby granting unto my said Attorney full my full power good Right and Lawfull authority in the premises the said person and persons or their Executors and adm and their goods and Chattells to sue arrest attach implead prosecute Imprison and out of prison to deliver Letters of acquittance & sufficient discharges for me and in my name to make seals and execute Attorney or Attorneys one or more under them to put and set forth and this same at his pleasure to Revoke suspend to make and Generally, all and every such further and other Lawfull Act and Acts thing and things as shall be needfull and necessary in or about the premises to doe or cause to be done as fully largely & amply as I myself might or could doe if I were personally present, Ratifying confirming & allowing all and what soever my said Attorney shall Lawfully doe or cause to be done in or about the Execution of the premises by virtue of these presents In witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand and seal the twenty fifth day of October Anno R^e Carol^o sec^o nune Angl^o & tric^o s^o Anno Domini One thousand six hundred seventy eight

Command was given to the Sheriff of Kent County, that he should search any the goods or Chattels of Thomas Pighon if they should be found in his custody to the value of twenty two pounds five shillings sterl and when he had the same so attached or any part thereof the same in his custody to keep until the said Thomas Pighon should by himselfe or his Attorney appear here the fifth day of March in the third year of the Dominion of the right Hon^{ble} Charles Lord Baltimore of Chevy Chase 1678 to answer unto John Burdett in a plea of trespass upon the case, on which said fifth day of March Michael Miller Sheriff of the County aforesaid was returned of the writ aforesaid, that by virtue thereof he had attached & Appraised the goods following as the proper goods of Thomas Pighon in following manner The Appraisement of the Goods of Thomas Pighon married by virtue of an Attachment directed to the Sheriff of Kent County for & to the use of John Burdett Attached for the Summe of twenty two pounds five shillings sterl
