 seals and delivon, and is bound to for the purposes to appear and the person of the said
 Constituant to represent in all Courts and before all Lords, Judges, Justices, and to doo say
 pursued implor, for request, arrest, imprison, & to condonnd, and out of prison againe
 when need shall be, to delivon, sum facultate substituendi and generally in and concerning
 the purposes and the Dependents thereof, to doo say, transact and accomplish all and
 whatsoever the said Constituant her self might or could doo personally, although she in attor
 requires more speciall authority than here is comprized, the said Constituant hereby promising
 to have and hold, altho to satisfy & performe for good and of volid for ever all whatsoever
 her said Attorney or his substitute shall lawfully doo or grow to be done in and about the
 purposes by vertue of the powers lastly, the said Attorney hereby declares that the power
 hereby given is in noo sense to extend to the sale or alienation of her plantation in
 Maryland aforesaid, nor is her said Attorney to in vendid to them without her approof

 Charles the Second Lord and Proprietary of the Province of Maryland
 Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. Doctyours Margaret Hall of the County of
 the County of St Maryes Spinster of the one part, and Phillip Salwort of the City of St
 Maryes Esq^r of the other part Witnesseth that the said Margaret for her
 Consideration of the sume of Twenty thousand pounds of Tobacco to her in hand paid
 whereof she hath hereby Generall acquit and discharged him the said Phillip Salwort
 his heires, Exors, Adors, Heirs, Executors, Administrators, Assignes, and Assignes
 confinde, and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien onfesse &
 him the said Phillip Salwort all those two hundred and fiftie acres of Land part or parcel of the Countie
 and Elizabeths Mannors situate lying and being in St Maryes County aforesaid by
 the last will and testament in writing of Walter Hall late of the said Countie of
 in her the said Margaret widow and Exors of him the said Walter legally testid, lying
 Eastward of a swamp in the said Mannors commonly called the Meadows swamp
 And beginning at the mouth of the said Meadow swamp, and running up the side of the
 said swamp to the dividing tree marked between the Lands of Markes Cross & him the
 said Walter containing by estimation two hundred acres of Land be it more or less
 together with all woods underwoods & timber wood, and all other profits and benefits
 out of this said Land arising or accruing or hereafter to arrive or accrue to have &
 to hold to him the said Phillip Salwort his heires, and assignes for ever In witness whereof
 the parties to these presents Incontrovers have in touch and seal, for their hands and seals the
