Deceased, in her the said Margarott Hall Widow and Executrix of his the said Walter Halls last will, Lying and being in the said Mammour commonly called the Meadow Swamp, and beginning at the mouth of the said Meadow Swamp & running up the side of the said Swamp to the dividing trees marked between the lands of Marko Indica and the said Walter Hall, containing by Estimation Twelve hundred acres of Land be it more or less, together with all woods and woods & Timber trees and all other profits and benefits Out of the said Land arising or accruing on hereafter to arise or accrue, To have to hold to her the said Margarott Hall her heirs Executors and assigns for ever.
