Maryland for Divers of a warrant of Return bearing date the 4th day of May 1670 granted by the Hon^{ble} Charles Calvert M^r John Hinson of Kent County, gild directed to the Jurors of this Province or his Deputy being in pursuance of a former grant unto the said Hinson and M^r Joseph Wickes of the same County, gild bearing date the twentieth of May 1670. To Return of these several tracts of Land in the said County lying in the Eastern Neck containing One thousand four hundred Acres according to the Division bounded, And the same to be divided into two Equal parts between the said Hinson and the said Wickes

These may humbly Certifie that Edward Swatnam Juror Jurors by the Hon^{ble} Council Lower of the said Province, to return and divide the said three tracts as aforesaid. has laid out for the said Joseph Wickes the Twelfth day of June 1670 a tract of Land called Wickes his Division formerly Wickliff, lying on the East side of Chesapeake bay in Kent County in the said River. Beginning at a marked burnt white oak tree standing on the Point of Land leading from the said Wickes his house to the oyster shell landing over against a long point of Marsh that maketh the mouth of the said River hard by a pond in the said Marsh, and running from the said burnt oak along the Eastern bay side North west four hundred and two score p^rches to a bounded Cyp^r Logg sticking in a Marsh neare a Cove called Cabbins Cove, & from the said Cyp^r Logg running still North west over the said Cove due hundred and twenty p^rches to another Logg sticking in the Marsh on the other side of the said Cove and from the end of the north west line by a line drawn north north west eighty five p^rches. And from the end of the north north west line by a direct line drawn to a bounded great white oak tree standing on the edge of the woods by the said Marsh side, And from the said great white oak by a line drawn East half a point southerly (being the line of Division) between the said John Hinson and Joseph Wickes, until it intersecteth the water of a Creek running out of the said River called Longneck Creek then from the end of the East half a point southerly line by a line drawn from the south side of the said Longneck Creek south East one hundred and twenty p^rches then from the end of the south East line by a line drawn south west two hundred and eighty p^rches to a Creek called Shortneck Creek running out of the said River aforesaid then from the end of the south west line by a line drawn south east over the said Shortneck Creek to a marked Chestnut stake sticking in the Marsh one hundred and forty p^rches then from the said Chestnut stake at the East Southeast line end by a direct line drawn to the first bounded burnt white oak tree bounded on the west by the said Eastern bay on the north by the East half a point southerly line, on the East by the said Longneck Creek and River, and on the south by the aforesaid line drawn from the aforesaid Chestnut stake to the first bounded white oak tree, containing and Now laid out for Eight hundred Acres more or less to be held of the Manor of Baltimore by the said Swatnam.
