 acknowledge And thereof and of Every part and particle thereof doth clearly and absolutely
 acquitt Exonorate and discharge him the said Daniell Moy his heires and tenuys by these
 presentes hath given granted bargayned aliened and sold and by these presentes doth hind
 Grant bargayne alon and sell unto the said Daniell Moy his heires and assigned forever
 All that partell of land called the Vineyard aforesaid according to the Measurē and Boundē
 before expressed Conteyning a d aforesaid by Estimator in the Whols Thre hundred fforly three
 acre or thereabouts with all and Every the lands Tenementes Rightes Numberes or appurtenantē
 to the said partell of land belonging or in any wise apperteyning together with all the Deeds
 Entituled Platēts Grants Charters Estriates writings and Mementes whatsoever of or
 Concerning the same To have and to hold the said land and promised to the Only proper use
 and behooffe of him the said Daniell Moy his heires and assigned for ever And the said
 Thomas Taylor doth hereby for and on the behalfe of the said George White his heire
 and tenuys and also for and on the behalfe of himself his heire and tenuys

 Standeth soizd of the said Land and Promised with thair appurtenantē off A firm

 Lawfull cluthority to Grant bargayne & Sell y^e Land to the said Daniell Moy and his
 heires And that he will for ever warrant and Defend the same to him the said Daniell
 Moy and his heires against all persons claiming any Right title or Interest of in or to the
 premises or any part therof and that the said Land and Promises are free and clear
 of all manner of Intrumbrances whatsoever the Rentes and Servitudes due and payable to

 alwayes Exempted and for prizod PROVIDED alwayes and it is the true intent and
 meaning of these presentes that if the said Richard Moy in his life time or the said Daniell

 and four being the time when the said Richard first received possession of the said Land
 and Promised, haue clapped paying the Rent of the said Land, or done or omitted any other
 thing wherby and by which invaded the said Land Should be forfeited to the Lord Proprietary
 or his heires Lord and Lords of the fee of the premises But then and in such case
 the said Warranty of the said Thomas to the said Daniell by these presentes given as to
 the Defending and Warranting the same Shall be void and of No Effect as if the same
 herein boore never interced any thing in this Deed to the contrary herof in any wise
 Notwithstanding And the said Thomas Taylor doth further for himself his heire
 and tenuys Covenant Promise and Agreed to and With the said Daniell Moy
 his heire and tenuys and every of them by these presentes att any time within
 these seaven yeares next coming at the Reasonable Request and att the proper tyme there
 in the Law of him the said Daniell Moy to doe Acknowledgē make and Executē any
 other lawfull Conveyancē or Conveyancē clyferante or clyferantes in the Law whereto
 to by ffirst Rotory or Enrolment of these presentes or otherwise whatsoever as by the
 Counsell of the said Daniell Moy learned in the law Shall be reasonably deuised Devise
